

Stakeholder Interview Questions

General

- Would you like to see more investment in roads, sidewalks, bikeways and transit?
- Are there any safety or operational issues that you feel need to be addressed through this study within the interchange areas?
- Do you have ideas or specific suggestions about how to address the issues you noted above?

Street Design

- What works well today as it relates to traffic access and circulation around the two freeway interchange areas (specify Exit 164 or 165)?
- How do you feel about the city street design standards (lighting, sidewalks, street trees, etc.)?

Access and Circulation

- As properties develop (or re-develop), how should truck and auto access be provided?
- How do the street spacing standards established by the city and ODOT relate to your answer above (ODOT: 770' separation to 1st RIRO, and 1,320' to 1st full access intersection; City: 600' separation between adjacent intersections)?
- Do you foresee any circulation issues associated with Front Street intersections being so close to the freeway ramps at Exit 164? If so, what do you suggest for us to consider in correcting them?

Multi-Modal Issues

- How could the city improve the bicycle and pedestrian access and safety around the freeway interchange?
- Would you be encouraged to bike around town, if there were more bike lanes, racks or other bike amenities?
- Does large truck parking impact traffic access and circulation near the interchange?

Funding

- What is the best way to fund the improvements identified through this plan?
- Would you be willing to contribute a share to any locally funded portion of the improvements?
- If you were to identify percentage of contributions to street improvement (e.g. pie chart) for arterial and collector streets using the following funding options, (System Development Charges, Local Improvement Districts, New Development pay their own way, City General Fund tax dollars, Local Gas Tax, Enterprise Zone negotiated payments, or others not identified here) how would you identify the percentages?
