HYDRANT METER AGREEMENT

The above applicant agrees to pick up & return the hydrant meter & gate valve to Boardman City Hall, located at 200 City Center Circle, for temporary water service pursuant to the following conditions:

FEES:

Payment of a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee is due at the time of application. This fee covers the meter installation (by the city), account set up, and removal. Payment of a \$500.00 refundable deposit is due at the time the hydrant meter is obtained and will be refunded when the hydrant meter is returned in good working order. In addition, the applicant will pay a monthly billing fee of \$21.53 for the first 8,000 gallons used. Water used in excess of the first 8,000 gallons will be charged at a rate of \$.84 per 1,000 gallons. Failure to reimburse the city for usage on a monthly basis will result in immediate termination of hydrant meter usage.

LOCATION OF METER:

The water used from a hydrant meter may be used outside the City limits. It is your responsibility to notify the City when you have moved the hydrant meter to a new location for monthly readings and inspections. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of the hydrant meter and indefinite suspension of hydrant water use privileges.

LIABILITIES:

The applicant assumes FULL RESPONSIBILITY for any and all damage to the hydrant meter, hydrant and/or the City of Boardman's water distribution system caused by the abuse, vandalism, neglect, or misuse of the hydrant meter. Costs associated with damage will be billed to the applicant by the City and could result in the denial of future use of a hydrant meter. The applicant should remove and secure the hydrant meter nightly for protection. DO NOT use the hydrant valve as your flow control valve. Turn the hydrant valve on completely and use the gate valve on the hydrant meter to control your water flow. All roadways and road shoulders shall be returned to the conditions they were in prior to the fire hydrant usage by the customer. The City reserves the right to shut down any customer's usage of the fire hydrant if damaging or unsafe practices are observed. The applicant further agrees to provide an approved backflow prevention device to protect the water distribution system.
